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# **Safety Information**

Welcome to Opel Mobile and thanks for purchasing our products. For the best performance, we recommend you read this manual carefully, especially the "safety instructions". This will take you a few minutes, but it will save you time later and will allow you to enjoy all the features on your device.

#### THIS MODEL MEETS INTERNATIONAL GUIDELINES FOR EXPOSURE TO RADIO WAVES

Your mobile device is a radio transmitter and receiver. It is designed not to exceed the limits for exposure to radio waves recommended by international guidelines. These guidelines were developed by the independent scientific organization ICNIRP and include safety margins designed to assure the protection of all persons, regardless of age and health.

The guidelines use a unit of measurement known as the Specific Absorption Rate, or SAR. The SAR limit for mobile devices is 2 W/kg and the highest SAR value for this device when tested on the body is 1.641 W/kg\*.

As SAR is measured utilizing the devices highest transmitting power the actual SAR of this device while operating is typically below that indicated above. This is due to automatic changes to the power level of the device to ensure it only uses the minimum level required to reach the network.

The World Health Organization has stated that present scientific information does not indicate the need for any special precautions for the use of mobile devices. They note that if you want to reduce your exposure then you can do so by limiting the length of calls or using a hands-free device to keep the device away from the head and body.

#### How to handle and preserve your device?

- Trying to modify, disassemble or repair the device or the charger yourself will make the warranty invalid. Only certified repairers may install or repair phone equipment.
- Avoid hitting or shaking your phone.
- The warranty of this phone may be annulled if you use unauthorised accessories. To prevent this from happening and to keep your phone working properly use only the battery charger and Micro USB cable that originally comes with the device.
- Make sure the device does not get wet. To avoid possible, short-circuit, electric shock or corrosion keep your phone away from rain, water splash, sweat or moisture. You must not use your device with your hands wet or immerse it in water. In case it gets wet keep the phone off and do not try to use a microwave to dry it.
- Do not use your phone when entering areas that are near flammable liquids.
- Observe all local laws and regulations on the use of mobile phones. Turn off the device before entering petrol stations, oil refineries or chemical plants.
- This product should not be used in extremely hot, cold, dusty, or humid spaces. It also should not be exposed to long periods of sunshine or strong magnetic fields.
- If you have a pacemaker keep the phone at least a 20cm distance from the place it is located. This phone may cause interference to some hearing aids and other electronic devices.
- Avoid all heat sources, ovens or other appliances (including amplifiers) that produce heat or have hot surfaces.
- Switch off the phone when entering an aircraft.
- Do not use a hand-held phone when operating any motor vehicles, heavy equipment or moving objects.
- Excessive high-volume levels or noise may affect your hearing. To prevent this from happening use an adequate volume in your earphones when you are listening to music or employing any of the multimedia features on the phone.
- You are fully responsible for keeping your information backed up and we do not take any legal responsibility for data that is damaged or lost. It is possible to erase or interfere with the information stored in your phone by a magnetic device when using your phone. To avoid this issue, keep your phone clear from magnetic devices.
- Pointing the torch into your own or another person's eyes will cause damage and may result in blindness.


#### Safety recommendations for accessories

- Use only Opel Mobile accessories or chargers that came with this phone.
- Be careful when handling the battery. The lithium-ion battery can be put into use immediately after being unpacked. Use only the Opel Mobile battery that came with the device. We recommend charging the battery as soon as possible once the phone has been switched on.

- Immediately stop using the battery charger if you smell an odour or overheats or a crack or swelling appears in the casing.



# **Quick Setup Guide**


1. Unpack all the contents out of the packaging and have your SIM card/s ready to be inserted into the main unit.

(Please note this phone supports both standard SIM and nano SIM card/s, if you do not have either of them, please contact your SIM card provider as they will be able to supply one for you)

- 2. Connect the handset to the main unit using the handset cord provided.
- 3. Remove the back cover from the main unit.




- 4. Remove the battery from the main unit by lifting from the top and pulling out.
- 5. Insert your SIM card/s into either one or both SIM trays according to its size.



For **SIM1**, slide a **standard SIM card** in to the right until it doesn't go in any further. Please ensure the gold plates are facing downwards and the cornered edge is in the lower left corner.

For **SIM2**, first slide the SIM tray door to the right and put a **nano SIM card** in, and then slide the SIM tray door to the left. Please ensure the gold plates are facing downwards and the cornered edge is in the upper right corner.

- 6. If you wish to insert an optional SD/TF memory card for extra phone storage, insert it into the memory card slot, ensure the gold plates are facing downwards when inserting it into the phone.
- 7. Re-insert the battery back into the main unit. Ensuring the gold plates on the battery and the main unit are aligned
- 8. Replace the back cover, push it down until it has clicked into place.
- 9. Connect the power adapter to the main unit's charge port located at the rear of the main unit using the Micro USB cable provided.



#### Turning the phone on for the first time

After connecting the power adapter, turn the phone on by holding down the Power button.

The phone will begin to boot, once finished booting, your phone is ready to be used. If your SIM card is inserted and is active, the time and date will be automatically set based on your location.

#### Powering the Device on and off

- 1. To power the device on hold down the Power button for 3 seconds.
- 2. To turn the phone off, long press the Power button for 3 seconds and select Power Off to confirm.

# **Quick User Guide**

#### Answer a call

To answer an incoming call, lift up the handset or press the green Answer button and the call will be answered.

#### End a call

To end a call, put the handset back to the main unit, or press the red End Call button.

#### Reject an incoming call

To reject an incoming call, press the red End Call button.

#### Silence an incoming call

To silence an incoming call, press the Volume Up or Down button.

#### **Quick adjust Ringtone volume**

While at home screen, press the Volume Up or Down button to adjust the ringtone volume.

#### **Notification LED light**

Red – blinking: Charging

Red - steady: Charging is completed


Green - blinking: Incoming call ringing

Green - steady: Missed call

Blue - steady: Unread messages

#### Dialling and using keypad numbers (123 mode)

1. To dial a phone number, press the numeric buttons on the keypad and then press the green Answer button, or wait for 4 seconds and the phone will dial the number automatically.



 To type numbers while creating a contact or writing a message, press the "Hash" # button or long press the OK button for 2 seconds until "123" Number mode appears.

#### Typing Letters (EN/Abc modes)

- 1. To type in letters, long press the OK button for 2 seconds to choose between EN (Word), Abc (Letter) and 123 modes
- 2. EN is the predictive text mode. (see predictive text below)
- 3. Abc is standard letter modes e.g. when in this mode to type the letter "c", press the "2 ABC" button 3 times until the letter "c" comes up.

#### Predictive text (EN mode)


Predictive text is a smart way to type messages. This feature can make typing easier by suggesting words based on what you are typing.

- 1. Use the keypad to type the word without pressing the same button multiple times e.g. To type "hello", press the "4, 3, 5, 5, 6" buttons once and the word "hello" will show up for selection. It also suggests other word options like what has been typed in.
- 2. To choose another candidate word, use the cursor keys to highlight it and then press the "OK" button or the "Space" 0 button to select the word.

#### Smileys / Emojis


To add Smileys / Emojis, use the cursor buttons to choose the Smiley icon on the status bar. Confirm your selection with the "OK" button.


# EasyCall

You can have 4 EasyCall contacts to make it easier to contact your most common or regular contacts.

 To set up an EasyCall contact, while at the home screen press the left cursor button. Using the cursor buttons to highlight an EasyCall position and press the OK button to open the contact list, highlight the contact you want to choose and press the OK button to add.




2. To delete an EasyCall contact, highlight the EasyCall contact, long press OK button and then confirm to Remove Contact.



- To dial an EasyCall contact, highlight the contact using the cursor buttons and press the OK button once, the phone will then attempt to dial that contact.
- You can also use the EasyCall I and II buttons on the keypad to dial their numbers directly.

# Phone Dialler

Press the green Answer button, or simply start dial a phone number to access the phone dialler.



To add the current number to Contacts, press the OK button to open the option menu and select "Add to Contacts".

To send a message to the current number, press the OK button to open the option menu and select "Send message".



- Within Call Forwarding you can select to always forward calls, forward when busy, forward when unanswered and forward when unreachable. Select the options you wish to use and turn them on. You can then choose which number you wish callers to be forwarded to. The default number will be your sim providers voicemail service.
- 2. Within **call barring** you can select to bar certain calls such as all outgoing calls, international outgoing calls, International outgoing home calls, all incoming calls, incoming calls while roaming and cancel all options. Select the options you wish to use.
- 3. Within **additional settings** you can adjust the caller ID settings and call waiting options.



**General settings** – Here you can turn on or off Automatic Call Recording, Prompts for call connection, Fade-in ringer and Quick SMS responses when busy.


# **Call History**

To access call history, use the cursor buttons to select the Call History icon and press the OK button to select it. Here you can view all your previous call records.




#### Dial a call from call history

To dial a call from the call history menu, highlight the person you want to call and press the green Answer button to bring up the Options menu, and then select "Call" menu item. You also can use the left and right cursor buttons to filter Missed / Outgoing / Incoming calls.



#### Call history menu options

To access the call history menu options, click the green Answer button to bring up the Options menu. Here you will be able to add as a new contact, add to existing contact, call, add to blacklist, clear call logs.



- 1. Add to contacts You can create a contact with the highlighted phone number, or add it to an existing contact.
- 2. **Call** Press the green Answer button to dial the number which is being highlighted.
- 3. Add to blacklist Add the highlighted phone number to blacklist, so that this number cannot call or send messages to you.
- 4. Clear call logs Click the OK button for selecting multiple items to delete.





To delete a contact, highlight the contact using the cursor buttons. Press OK button to view the details, and then press Options button and select "Delete" to delete it.




#### Searching contacts




#### Add a contact to blacklist

To add a contact to blacklist, highlight the contact using the cursor buttons. Press OK button to view the details, and then press Options button and select "Add to blacklist".




#### Assign a ringtone to a contact

To assign a ringtone to a contact, highlight the contact using the cursor buttons. Press OK button to view the details, and then press Options button and select "Set ringtone".




#### **Contacts to display**

To select contact types to display, press the Options button and press the OK button on "Contacts to display". You can adjust to view all contacts or customise on what contacts to display.






#### 1. Copy to



#### 3. Export Contacts



Within Export, you can export your phones contacts onto your sim card or TF card. Choose where you want to export from and then press ok on next. Then choose where you want to copy the contacts to and then press ok on next. Now select which contacts you wish to copy using the OK key and then press the options button to complete.




#### 4. Share Contacts

To share contacts via Bluetooth or Messaging, select "Share visible contacts" and then Bluetooth or Messaging using the OK button. Then select the contacts you want to copy by using the OK button and press the Options button to confirm sharing.



#### **Batch Delete**

To select multiple contacts to delete, press the Options button and press the OK button on "Batch Delete". You can select the contacts you want to delete by using the OK button, and press the Options button to confirm deletion.



#### **SIM capacity**

To view how many contacts have been saved to the SIM cards, press the Options button and press the OK button on "SIM capacity".



# Messaging

To access SMS and MMS messages, press the OK button on the Messaging icon from the home screen.

Here you can view previous conversations and messages or create new messages to message your friends and family. Messages from the same contact or phone number will be grouped into one thread, so it is easy for you to follow conversations.


#### View messages


# Blacklist




# SOS – Emergency Call

The SOS feature is designed for people who may need the function to easily contact their family or close friends if they are ever in need of help.

When the SOS is activated, it will send a text message to all your SOS contacts with a predetermined customisable message. After it sends out the text messages it will then attempt to ring your SOS contacts until someone answers the call.

To activate the SOS feature, press the SOS button 3 times until you hear the SOS siren. If you want to cancel or end the SOS feature, press the red End Call key.




1. Enable the SOS feature by pressing the OK button on "Emergency Call", when the toggle is blue it means this feature is turned on.

# **Troubleshooting and support**

If you are experiencing difficulties with your phone, please go through the following troubleshoots:

#### The Phone will not power on

- 1. Ensure the battery is inserted correctly.
- 2. Ensure the phone is connected to the power adapter.
- 3. Ensure you have removed the battery sticker from the gold connection pins.
- 4. Ensure you are pressing and holding the power button for 5 seconds to turn the phone on.

#### The phone is asking for a PUK code

1. This means you have input the incorrect password 3 times or more. Contact your network provider to retrieve your PUK code to unlock your phone. Only your network provider can help unlock your SIM.

#### SIM card error or no SIM card

- 1. Ensure you have inserted the SIM card correctly and are using the correct size SIM card. Follow instructions in the quick set up guide for installing the SIM card.
- 2. Your SIM card may be damaged or dirty. Ensure you replace your SIM with your network provider if this error occurs.

#### Failure to connect to the network

- 1. Your network signal may be weak or out of range. Contact your network provider or try the phone in a different location to check your signal.
- 2. Your SIM card may be damaged, invalid or has no credit. Contact your network provider for support.

3. Ensure you have enough credit on your network provider's account. Contact your network provider for support.

#### Failure to make an outgoing call

- 1. Ensure you have entered the correct phone number you wish to dial.
- 2. Ensure you have enough credit on your network provider's account. Contact your network provider for support.
- 3. Your signal strength may be weak. Check your signal strength and contact your network provider.

#### **Cannot receive calls**

- 1. Ensure your phone is switched on.
- 2. Ensure you have enough signal strength to receive calls.
- 3. Ensure you do not have the phone in flight mode.
- 4. Ensure your SIM card is installed correctly.

#### Cannot hear anyone on the call

- 1. Ensure your call volume is adjusted to your requirements. Using the volume buttons on the phone's keypad.
- 2. Ensure you have sufficient signal strength.

#### The other party cannot hear you on the call

- 1. Ensure you have lifted the handset up and place the earpiece near to your ears, or pressed the speakerphone button for loud speaker mode.
- 2. Ensure your hand or fingers are not covering the microphone.
- 3. Ensure you are speaking directly into the microphone.
- 4. Ensure you have not muted the call.
- 5. Ensure the other party has their volume turned up to their desired level.

#### Phone won't charge

1. Ensure the power plug is inserted in the wall socket correctly and the wall switch is turned on.

- 2. Ensure the wall power socket is working by testing another device or a separate power socket.
- 3. Ensure you have inserted the Micro USB cord into the phone correctly.
- 4. Ensure there is no dirt or dust accumulated in the phones power socket.
- 5. Ensure you have left the phone on charge for at least 10 minutes as the battery may have run out of charge completely.

#### Phone won't connect via Bluetooth

- 1. Ensure you have turned on and activated the Bluetooth setting.
- 2. Ensure you follow the Bluetooth instructions above.
- 3. Ensure the other device has Bluetooth enabled.
- 4. Your Bluetooth device may be too far away from the other device to connect. Ensure you are within range of this device to connect.

#### Phone won't connect to Wi-Fi

- 1. Ensure you have turned on and activated Wi-Fi on your phone. See Wi-Fi guide in the manual.
- 2. Ensure the Wi-Fi you are connecting to is working.
- 3. Your device may be too far away from the Wi-Fi Router. Ensure you are within range of this device to connect



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
